### Program Summary

Duration: Two-week program (Flexible start dates: Arrive on Sunday, depart on Saturday)

Extensions are available (Monthly participation also possible)



Age :Solo participation from age 16 (Parental consent required)

Accomodation: Dormitory-style accommodation: 4-6 people per room, separated by gender

Meal: Three meals a day; on weekends, breakfast and dinner only

Country: Ubud, Bali, Indonesia / or Chiang Mai, Thailand



Program Content: This is a two-week program. In the first week, participants will gain a deep understanding of the local culture through learning about traditional arts, customs, and daily life, as well as interacting with local people.

In the second week, participants can choose a volunteer activity based on their English level and personal interests. A variety of volunteer programs are available to match your preferences.

• Thailand's Serene Oasis: Where Nature and Culture Come Alive

Chiang Mai is a historic city located in northern Thailand, with a rich history spanning over 700 years. As the former capital of the Lanna Kingdom, it is home to numerous ancient temples and cultural heritage sites. One of the most famous temples is Wat Doi Suthep, located on a mountain summit, offering a panoramic view of Chiang Mai's beautiful landscape.

Chiang Mai's cuisine is another highlight, with traditional northern dishes like Khao Soi (curried noodles) and Larb (spicy minced meat salad) offering unique flavors. The climate is generally mild, with the dry season (November to February) being the most pleasant time to visit. With its blend of nature, history, and culture, Chiang Mai is a truly captivating city.

#### **★**Constraction

Join the Construction Program in Chiang Mai and help make a real difference in the local community. This program focuses on improving essential facilities such as schools, temples, and healthcare centers to support better living conditions and overall well-being for residents. You will actively participate in hands-on tasks such as painting walls, cleaning, plastering, and roof repairs—directly helping to create safe and functional spaces. Your work will also contribute to improving homes for those in need, making a meaningful impact on their daily lives.

### Airport pick-up at Chiang Mai International Airport



Flights arriving within the designated time: 08:00–16:00 at CNX (Chiang Mai) Airport, 1st floor, Door 5.

If you are arriving on an international flight, please exit the arrival hall and stay on the same floor, then turn left and walk toward Gate 5. If you are arriving on a domestic flight, please exit the arrival hall and stay on the same floor, then turn right and walk toward Gate 5. This area can be crowded, so please wait near the entrance if possible and look for a coordinator holding a "The Green Lion" sign among the many people holding signs.



It takes at least one hour from arrival to the meeting point (including immigration and customs). Please plan accordingly.
